# Vision

- GLOMUS is a global student-centered network for higher education in music, drama and dance.
- GLOMUS network aims to develop collaborative projects to enhance:
  - Intercultural communication and knowledge sharing
  - Institutional capacity building and organizational development
  - Empowerment of people
  - Artistic interaction for mutual inspiration and innovation
  - Cross-disciplinarity within the arts

# More formalized GLOMUS structure

- New suggested GLOMUS structure
  - General Assembly for decision-making
  - Executive Committee for daily running of network
  - Rotating chairmanship (2-year-term)
  - Membership fee (different categories)
  - Sub-groups focusing on certain areas/themes
    - E.g. E-learning, African circle, fundraising, camp content group, social media and communications



# More formalized GLOMUS structure

- Transition period
  - Present Steering Group + resource persons (by request) continue and prepare the transition
  - New Executive Committee will be chosen in the first General Assembly
  - Evaluation of the camp
  - Call for future Camp hosts
  - Mapping funding possibilities



# Between camps activities

- Encouraging members to initiate "between camps" activities
  - Regional meetings/minicamps (African circle?)
  - Transcultural Confluence (Lyon)
  - Minicamp in Italy
  - Application for Nordic Council of Ministers (Africa meets the Nordics)
  - Erasmus + KA107
  - GLOMUS Festival in Natal???
  - Global Music Master's (GLOMAS) students' field studies, e.g. in Natal
